The process of Canonization of the Venerable Mother Paula, remains open, waiting for a miracle by her intercession, which is certified by doctors and approved by the Holy Father.

Her heroic experience of the virtues, has been certified with the affirmative votes of the theologian consultants of the Causes of Saints, which gave way to the Decree of Pope Francis, declaring the Servant of God as Venerable, July 7, 2017.

Mother Paula was a woman of great charity to the poor, the sick and the elderly. She led a whole life devoted to God and others. It is a great source of hope, as the Theologians say -

"We ought to live a life of pure faith; this faith is so nice to God, Our Lord, that it brings abundant graces for the soul."

4. THE SAVITION. Ricardo Enrique Arévalo Galdámez. St. Jude Tadeo Church.

The reason for writing humble lines is to make known what happened in my life, a very great testimony that God has made in me, thanks to the intercession of M. Paula of Jesús Gil Cano.

One Sunday I received her stamp from to Franciscan Sister, after mass, I was glad when she handed it to me in my hands, I felt in my heart great joy and I kept the stamp in my wallet.

One day in the morning I would go out to my work very hasty and on the runway, I would pray asking the servant of God to take care of my way, to cover me with her blessing, but I did not know what would happen.

When I got to the market, walking down the street I heard someone who told me, stand there and a young man told me that they had sent him to kill me and he pulled out his gun and pointed it at me to take my life and I watched that my friends were passing and brothers of the church and they only passed by, and I said to the young man: you know what you will do, but I remember that in the low voice I said: you will kill my body but my soul and my spirit belong to my God, and I began to ask the servant Paula, and then I began to pray the prayer of the Our Father, when suddenly a friend came from the young man who wanted to take my life said: What is the matter? and the young man replied that he had been sent to kill me; the other friend said, "no, you've made a mistake you're not going to kill him, I'll speak for you so they don't do anything to you" and the other young man jumped with anger, then with her eyes full of tears put the gun down and they left.

I was frozen with fear, but I bear witness to this beautiful miracle and I have no way to pay my Lord and the Servant Paula of Jesus Gil Cano to help me in that difficult time. I give this testimony with great gratitude.



COSTA RICA, Carthage. Alicia Brenes Monge. For me the life and work of Mother Paula, has been a great example to follow. I've learned to approach those most in need. I have also involved my family and that has me very happy as my children grow up alongside the example of Mother Paula.



1. SPAIN, Murcia: My name is Ma. Angels M. Cortez. A few days ago, a friend came to me grieving as her husband by profession trucker had to leave with a transport to Germany, despite being sick and feverish. Arriving at his destination he was so bad that he couldn't even unload the truck. I've asked those who worked there, by a doctor or a pharmacy, but no one understood him, either in Spanish or in Romanian, his language. He also doesn't know any German, as he could spent the night in the truck and in the morning the other saw companions him so bad that they called an ambulance. He was taken to the hospital and found the same language problem.

Despite not being of my own religion, I gave her a stamp of Mother Paula, and together with many faiths in her we prayed to her for her husband. This, amid his gravity, agreed on some compatriots working in Germany, called them on his cell phone and they spoke to the doctor, who said they would watch for preventive treatment, for three days. After those three days the husband got better and was able to return to Spain.

A few days later my friend's mother had to be admitted to the hospital to have surgery on her head because she was about to go blind and with severe headaches. In Romania where this lady

resides, health is not free, so she did not count with means for the operation, hospital stay, etc.

Again we implored Mother Paul to help her. A friend gave them the necessary money, the operation was carried out and everything went satisfactorily. A small thrombus that touched the nerve was removed. Within a week she was able to return home and is well. For both favors, we thank and bless Mother Paula and send donations for her beatification prompt.



2. Cuba: Mrs. Juana Luisa *Caraballoso Iglesias* shares that because she could not have children, she and her husband decided to adopt one and began the efforts, encountering a number of difficulties. They began to entrust themselves to Mother Paula so that they could overcome everything and achieve adoption.

"In January 2016 we did the Ninth to Mother Paula and on the 18th we went to the Church of San Antonio in Havana and on my knees, I asked her with heart and truth (I almost claimed her)

- End of February: we are made the proposal by the Ministry of the Family of Managua, Nicaragua, of a child of 10 months".

Juana Luisa and her husband Lino A. Reyes Tur recorded their efforts in both Cuba and Nicaragua, overcoming one difficulty after another, so it was nine months, until finally *"on December 20th: the child is registered as David Reyes Caraballoso, our son. That same day in the afternoon we go to immigration from Managua to do the paperwork to come to Cuba. On December 21, all is ready and the 30th December, we happily arrived in Cuba.*

Mother Paula: Thank you for everything and for all that we always appreciate your presence. On January 18, 2017 we, together with our son have brought the offerings to the altar, offering the Eucharist in thanks giving. A million thanks.

It is really a miracle of Mother Paula to have been able to adopt my son David Reyes Caraballoso."

My nephew Milton David Cabrera was out of a job, the brick shop he had was no longer profitable; the wife worked but it was not enough, as they have three children to educate, train and provide them with what is necessary materially...

One day I told her that Mother Paula, our founder, is a defender for the poor and she must help them get out of that poverty. Everyone prayed to her the prayer of the ninth with great faith.

They decided to go to the United States, although they found it difficult to be given a visa for all five. They went to the American Embassy to request it and what a great surprise, they were all granted; they say they were hardly asked questions and told them, "Approved visas, you can travel." They all help is attributed to Mother Paula, they traveled on August 22, 2017, in September they already had work my nephew Milton, his wife Karla and their son David, 19 years old; the two little ones at school in third and fifth grade. For my part, every day they commend them to Mother Paula and they pray a lot and they carry with them a stamp of the Servant of God.
