Bulletin No. 56 2020 The Marian spirituality of the Servant of God was dominated by the heavenly Mother Mary Pure. Spiritually Mother Paula focused on the motherhood of Mary who, because of her motherhood, was worthy of absolute confidence. From where it follows that the way of the Servant of God was that of a Marian spiritual childhood. This is probably explained by the lack and need of the earthly mother, - how little she could enjoy her mother, Mrs Catalina Cano! - and also by the desire, all with her humility, to want to give, both to her nuns and to her orphans, the joy of having a mother capable of reaching where it would have been impossible for herself, says Professor Ulderico Parente, in the book Biography of Mother Paula.

As reflected in the Exemplary Life, with love and filial trust it was said to the Most Pure Virgin: "My Mother, You and not I are the Mother of these nuns and Superior General of this Congregation; watch over them, for the love and increase of this little flock. You know I'm just a delegate of yours."

She spoke with great enthusiasm of the distinguished mystery of the Immaculate Conception and exhorted her daughters to honor the Immaculate Queen: How beautiful my Mother of Heaven is, she said with joy. No one should celebrate our beloved Mother as much as us!

The Venerable Mother Paula fully trusted the Blessed Virgin, she entrusted her fears, her sorrows, her needs and those of her Daughters, as well as the intentions and needs of the people entrusted to her in her prayers.

The Most Pure is the *one full of grace* and therefore also of glory. The Servant of God, she sang in her beautiful voice, according to tradition, several prayers, and hymns to the Mother of God, for example: "Beautiful Virgin Take Me to Heaven", whose first verse says:

"Beautiful virgin, sweet comfort, Mother whom I love with frenzy. Take me Mother, take me to heaven, I can't live, away from You."



When there was any difficulty, she went to Our Lady and with great confidence said to her, "Go, dear Mother, go ahead and give us the way, you solve the matter first" (V.E. 106)

2018 she realized she was pregnant, the child was born on October 04, 2018, I found out a year later. I send the testimony of her. "I realized I was pregnant on February 21, 2018. The baby was born on October 4, 2018. It is so immense the love of God and the intercession of Mother Paula, that I spent a month in hospital Mexico for complications, my baby was going to be born early but God never abandoned us and my son was born very healthy despite so many scares. His name is Mathías Gael Torres Villegas. The dad's name is Carlos Luis Torres Juarez. And my full name: Alexandra Dallana Villegas Quesada.

I hesitated to get pregnant for 8 (eight) years, doctors told me it was because-I had polycystic ovaries, with a hyperinsulinemia condition. I had both fallopian tubes clogged, they could only open a tube for me, I had the smallest uterus than usual, that meant I had a juvenile reproductive system.

They gave me medication to get ovulate since my body did not do it so I could have an artificial insemination and even with ovulating medications, so they couldn't do the insemination. The moment I got pregnant I was still in treatment, but not much hope was seen, at the moment it looked like it was going to last much longer in treatment.

The date the ninth came to leave me (Sister Martha Nuria Masís V.) I do not remember much but if I know that in 2015"

From my behalf, "says Sister Martha Nuria, - "I asked Mother Paula to get in the way of that marriage, and so it was.



6. HONDURAS: Santa Rosa de Copán, 2019. Anonymous.

I am a friend of Madre Paula (of the group) and my granddaughter Marta Isabel Romero Rodríguez, was born with respiratory deficiency and the pediatrician said that it was necessary to intubate her and therefore had to be taken to the hospital. At the moment I thought I'd ask the family to join in prayer through Mother Paula's intercession and then take her to the hospital. When we arrived at the hospital with the girl, the pediatrician asked why we were taking her if the girl was okay. But for now they left her under observation for three days. By the grace of God and the intercession of Mother Paula, her recuperation was complete.
