### **WOMAN OF HOPE:**

**Great waiting capacity.**

The Venerable Mother Paula was a woman full of hope in the Providence of God, a virtue that sustained her in the initiatives of charity, on the path to the approval of her foundation and in facing the trials of life until the illness that led to her death, declare the theologian consultants. Her hope had a Marian connotation: it was Our Lady who inspired her with her wishes for good, supported her efforts and, in prayer, gave her the courage to insist even with Father Panadero so that he interposed his good offices, adds one of the consultants.

"Not only was the wait filled with prayer; It was also so after he had achieved what he had hoped for, which it

became a thanksgiving and a reason to expand confidence in other goals to benefit the poor. The hope of the Servant of God was the capacity to expect and accept the suffering that it entailed. Such can be considered the 14-year wait for the approval of the Institute, which came in 1903. In the longed-for goal, Mother Paula, far from letting herself be carried away by inertia, was rather diligent and left nothing untried, as in the case of asking until she obtained the commendative letters indispensable for the approval of the Institute.

The hope of attaining an earthly result was also the hope of future reward, which it invoked upon all those who had shown themselves willing to comply with its requests. And to all those whom he helped in their material need, it also offered hope for the future with trust in divine providence."

The day I finished my father's novena for the recently deceased, I was alone, in a hurry because people were already coming and I still had a lot to do and in the same way, I went to Mother Paula and immediately three people came to me at the same time to help me. I am a mother with two children, my daughter lost her job in March, when Covid-19 arrived and my son the same in April, he is in charge of two girls (he is a cook by profession). Days and months go by and hotels and restaurants continue to close; The situation is getting worse and worse. I trust M. Paula. I met the Franciscan Sisters (of the Immaculate Conception), they were always in my heart.

In September, my son called me that his financial situation was at its limit. I put myself in the hands of M. Paula to intercede, knowing that what she was asking for was almost impossible. **6. COSTA RICA:** San Jose, October 29, 2018. J. E. I. In September 2016 I entered the Casa Paz y Bien, Community for Older Adults located in Guadalupe Montelimar, San José, Costa Rica, on the recommendation of my daughter Alice, since at the age of 92, I was unexpectedly at risk of greater dangers to my personal safety, due to a serious accident that J. L. Eldest son of my second wife María E., At the age of 59, he had a very serious accident on his motorcycle. He has been left with his right arm, totally paralyzed and has since demanded more careful attention from his mother, then 83 years old and practically reduced in her physical capacities by a fall that together, she and I, had in a shopping center; She broke her pelvis in two sections in a row and while still convalescing, she immediately faced the new emerging situation with her son, who arrived unexpectedly with his suitcases, claiming that he had been dismissed from his residence, by his two adult children.

All this tragedy induced my wife to censure my attitude in a letter she sent me during the month of my absence, calling my sudden departure "as having broken her life." The next day I replied that our conjugal being was not broken nor disunited, but temporarily withdrawn while the difficult situation that seized us both was being arranged.

To safeguard my commitment to chastity, and to express my love to her from another room, I pledged myself before the Blessed Virgin of God. to protect in her my continence, chastity and fidelity, strengthened in this my House of Peace and Goodness, with the frequent Eucharist and in constant growth of my spirit, consecrated to Jesus Our Lord.

It is my wife's opinion that her daughter A. E., who was 57 years old at the time, was affected by my absence and resentful of life, cut off the intra-family relationship with her mother, her brother and other members of her immediate family, giving herself up in life, two years ago to liquor and smoking, and recently, She also neglected her filial relationship, with her two adult children, who have lived with her for more than twenty-three years, having sent them away from her own home.

All this family tragedy, with different traits of heartbreak, has affected my wife deeply in her feelings and in her health.

She is kind and of unsullied dignity, who has not ceased to attend to the needy in their economic distress or to those who, knocking on the door, ask for the economic contribution to eat and drink.

In the face of all this tragic family upheaval, I learned in this House of Peace and Good, the invitation to pray for the Franciscan Sister of the Most Purest Conception, Mother Paula Gil Cano, who is granting favors to receive, through our Father God, the recognition of the Beatification for her numerous participations in the tempestuous life of other living beings who have accepted her holy intercessions.

About a month ago, M. arrived with a priest from the Parish of the Piedades District at A.E.'s house, but she did not answer the door or answer phone calls. I am sure that Mother Paula has already heard my requests, and I can attest to the favor we have received through her intercession, two days ago, A.E. received in her home her Mother Maru and her two children, who had lunch with her, having already noticed an awakening of soul in A.E.

I want to make clear these good events that have begun to straighten out the family labyrinth that surrounds my wife, who is the center of this family, disjointed emotionally and spiritually, and for this reason, I will continue to pray to Mother Paula who is today our great hope, together with Jesus and Mary our mother, to untie the demonic knot that has tied A.E. and restore peace to M. that two years ago began to be lost due to the absence of faith in this family of his.
